French-language circus incursions for primary and secondary schools across Victoria. Students juggle, spin plates and try flower sticks while French runs through the whole session — bringing the language to life through movement, participation and fun.

What the program is

The French Circus School delivers French-language circus incursions for students from Prep to Year 12. Students experience French through movement, participation, interaction, play and circus activities. The program complements existing French teaching, bringing the language to life in a completely different way.

Circus is the method. French is the point. Every instruction, game and activity gives students a reason to hear, understand and use French in action.

Inside a session

01 French welcome and interaction

Students are immersed in French from the start through greetings, simple questions, counting, colours and playful interaction.

02 Foulard game

Students respond to French body-part vocabulary through movement, listening and a fast-paced scarf game.

03 Juggling

Students learn and practise juggling, with instructions and encouragement in French and activities adapted to their age and level.

04 Flower sticks and spinning plates

Students try new circus skills while continuing to listen, respond and interact in French.

How French is used

French and English are used according to students' level. French runs throughout the session — from greetings and games to the instructions for the circus activities themselves — with language adapted so every student can understand and take part.

The aim is to let students experience French in action while doing something active, enjoyable and memorable. No prior French is required, and the program works equally well for experienced French learners and students encountering the language for the first time.

Planning your day
